Reward increased: The **National Gay and Lesbian Task Force** on Tuesday increased its reward to \$25,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person they claim murdered Andrew Anthos -- even though county coroners concluded he died of natural causes. The Task Force and Triangle Foundation believes the 72 year-old from Detroit was a victim of a hate crime when he was found unconscious Feb. 13. A spokeswoman for the Triangle Foundation claimed police failed to thoroughly investigate.
