



Grant Aims to Expand Pro-Gay Church

A \$1.2 million grant given to the **National Gay and Lesbian Task Force** Foundation's Institute for Welcoming Resources and five partner organizations will be spent increasing the "capacity and voice of Christian organizations that support gays and lesbians," according to the Christian Post.

For Kermit Rainman, social research analyst for Focus on the Family, calls the move a "false doctrine [that] is playing out in denomination after denomination, with increasing discord."

According to the Post, more than 3,100 churches throughout the country already give explicit welcome to lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender people for full membership and interaction in their congregations.
